1. Introduction

This year has been one of growth, innovation, and heartfelt connection for Little Hiccups. As a Leeds-based, parent-led charity, we continue to support families with children who have disabilities or additional needs. Our mission remains clear: no family should feel isolated.

2. Key Achievements

- Membership grew to 1,354 families, up from 1,049 in 2024.
- Relaunched Accessible Yoga with a focus on parent/carer wellbeing.
- Piloting Theatre Dance Group during summer holidays.
- Expanded educational courses with daytime and evening options.
- Shortlisted for the National Diversity Awards 2025.
- Continued success of Compassion Packs and Mosaic Trail.

Over 100 events were delivered, including:

- Stay n Play sessions revamped with monthly themes and sensory activities.
- Family Fun Days such as Eid Party, Superhero Day, and Summer Picnic.
